First in Our Class: Congrats, Eryn!

Eryn Rich (McDaniel College '19) is SquashWise's first college graduate! She is an inspiring role model for the younger students who follow in her footsteps at SquashWise.



A member of our very first cohort, Eryn participated in SquashWise consistently from 7th grade through high school and college. She graduated from McDaniel College in May with a degree in Exercise Science, a field that interested her in large part because of her experience as a student-athlete at SquashWise. She is pursuing her career ambition to become an occupational therapist, and has landed her first job as a rehabilitation technician at an area hospital.

Looking back on her time at SquashWise, Eryn celebrated many accomplishments:

- Named SquashWise Student of the Year (2011).
- Won First Place in the Squash and Education Alliance (SEA) national essay competition (2013).
- Competed in 11 squash tournaments, including Howe Cup, the national women's team event.
- Interned at Teach for America's Delta Institute through SEA's college internship program (2018).

Eryn is the first of many SquashWise students who will walk across the stage to receive their college degrees. She has set the bar high for our future graduates, particularly two other students who have enrolled at McDaniel after her. Overall, 82% of SquashWise alumni have matriculated to college, in comparison to only 51% of their peers from Baltimore City Public Schools. Citywide, only 12% of Baltimore City high school graduates receive a two or four-year college degree (Baltimore's Promise). Students like Eryn and her peers in our college pipeline are changing the face of college graduation in Baltimore City.

From the beginning, it was evident that SquashWise wants their students to succeed & that they will do all that they can to be an influential part of that process.

When it comes to career development, the old adage that 'it's not what you know, but who you know' is now being bolstered by new research revealing the critical impact of developmental relationships on college access and professional advancement.

At SquashWise, the core of our program has always been about expanding access to opportunity and building relationships through squash: inviting young people to try a previously unknown sport, to become part of a team, and to develop lasting bonds with consistent, caring adult mentors in addition to their existing circles. Our students learn to navigate new spaces through travel matches and tournaments, college and workplace visits, and summer enrichment opportunities, and they make meaningful connections with others across lines of difference through a shared passion for sport.

When opportunity knocks, who will be standing at the door? Together with our peer programs in the Squash and Education Alliance, SquashWise is opening the world of squash to welcome the newest generation of players, who are using squash as a pathway to college and career success. The Relationship Gap & Our Relationship Map

"If diverging income levels remain the starkest drivers of unequal childhoods, then relationships are arguably becoming the best-hidden asset in the modern opportunity equation."¹

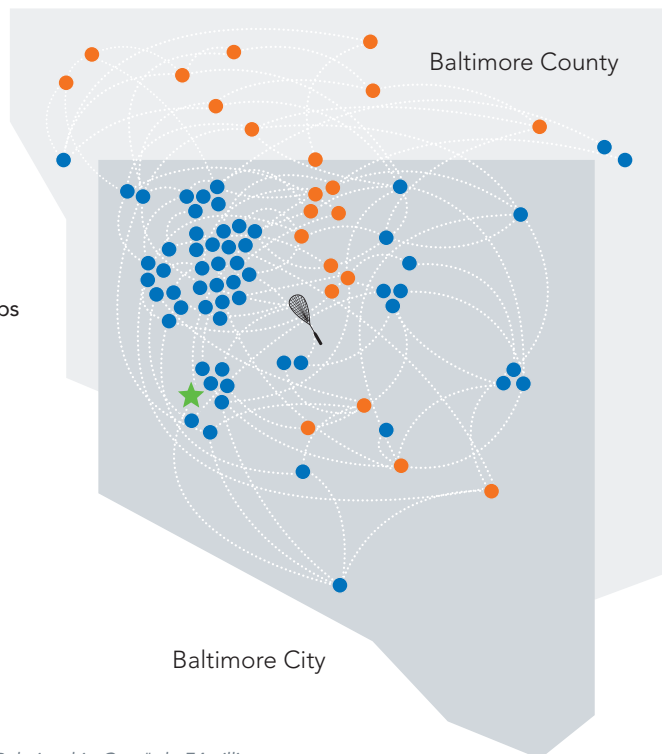
Research by The Search Institute on the "Relationship Gap" found that roughly 50% of job opportunities are secured through personal relationships, and social networks have become major assets in attaining educational and professional goals. Yet "too few young people experience a strong web of relationships" connected to college and career access, particularly in under-resourced communities.²

SquashWise is helping to close the Relationship Gap because sports—particularly squash—build meaningful relationships.

Ask anyone who has played squash, recreationally or competitively, and they all will share a story of how squash helped them meet a close friend, land a dream job, or enjoy a college experience with peers on a squash team.

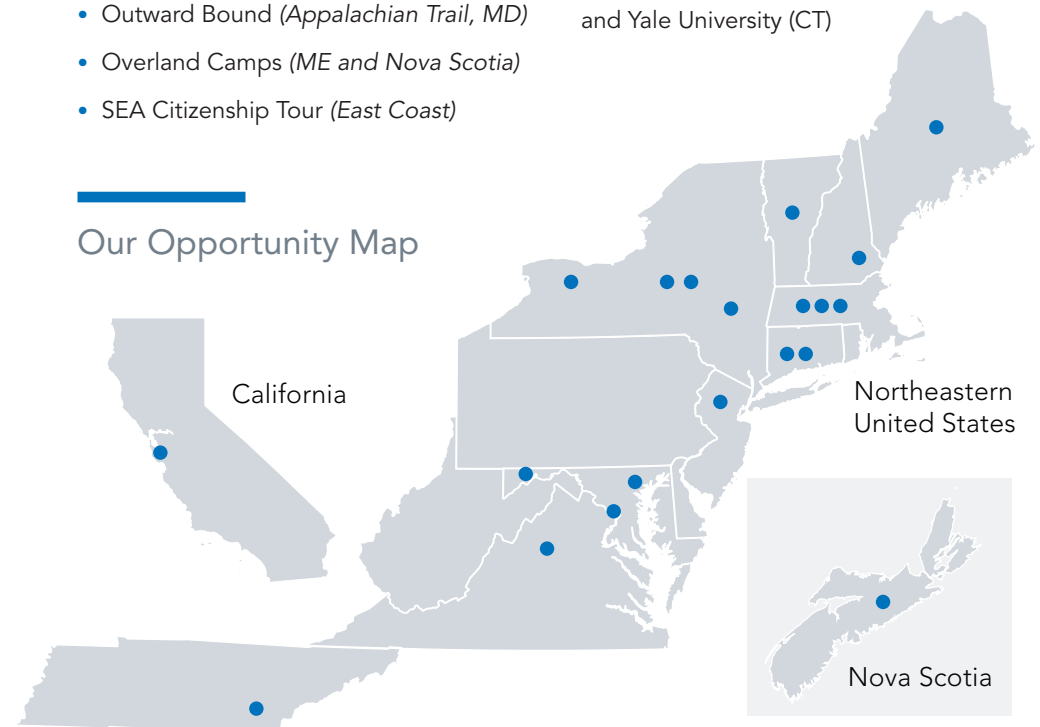

Strategies & Successes

SQUASHWISE PILLARS

Three Program Pillars frame our holistic approach to helping every student develop their full potential:

Education: Develop motivated, goal-oriented students who are on track to succeed in post-secondary college and/or career opportunities.

Squash & Fitness: Lead a thriving squash program with a good balance of hard work, competitiveness, and fun.

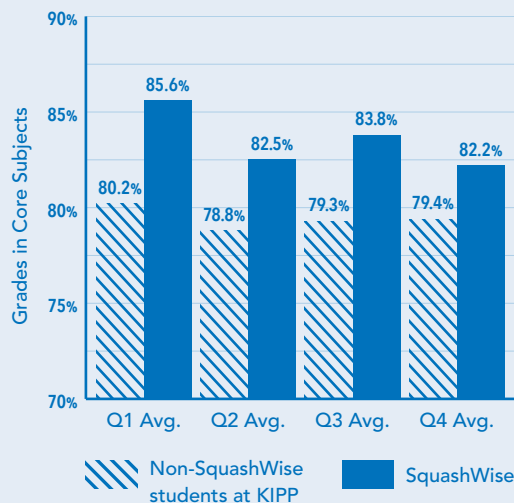
Support & Wellness: Create a second home and a second family for students, and support them in making positive decisions toward life goals.

EDUCATION

- 82% of our 8th graders qualified for high schools with entry requirements.
- 100% of our high school seniors graduated on time, moving on to college or the military.
- 19 SquashWise alumni received regular check-ins, scholarship support and visits from staff.
- 82% of our graduates to date have matriculated to college, in comparison to only 51% city-wide.

Middle School GPA Comparison

SquashWise students outperformed their peers at KIPP in every quarter during the school year, averaging 4 points higher in core subjects. All Rookies and 77% of returning middle school students ended the year with a GPA over 80%. Among our rookies, 30% showed significant growth in GPA, gaining between 5-10 points by the end of the year.



SQUASH & FITNESS

- 76% of students participated in at least 3 external squash matches, and 35% played in 10 or more!
- Students participated in 23 sanctioned tournaments hosted by U.S. Squash and/or the Squash + Education Alliance.
- 100% of summer camp participants improved in at least one fitness measure, and 79% improved in all three measures.
- The High Performance Team grew from 12 to 16 students, who submitted 108 entries in 22 tournaments.

SUPPORT & WELLNESS

SquashWise provides a safe and supportive environment with caring adults present to help with academic, social, and emotional challenges.

One student reflected,

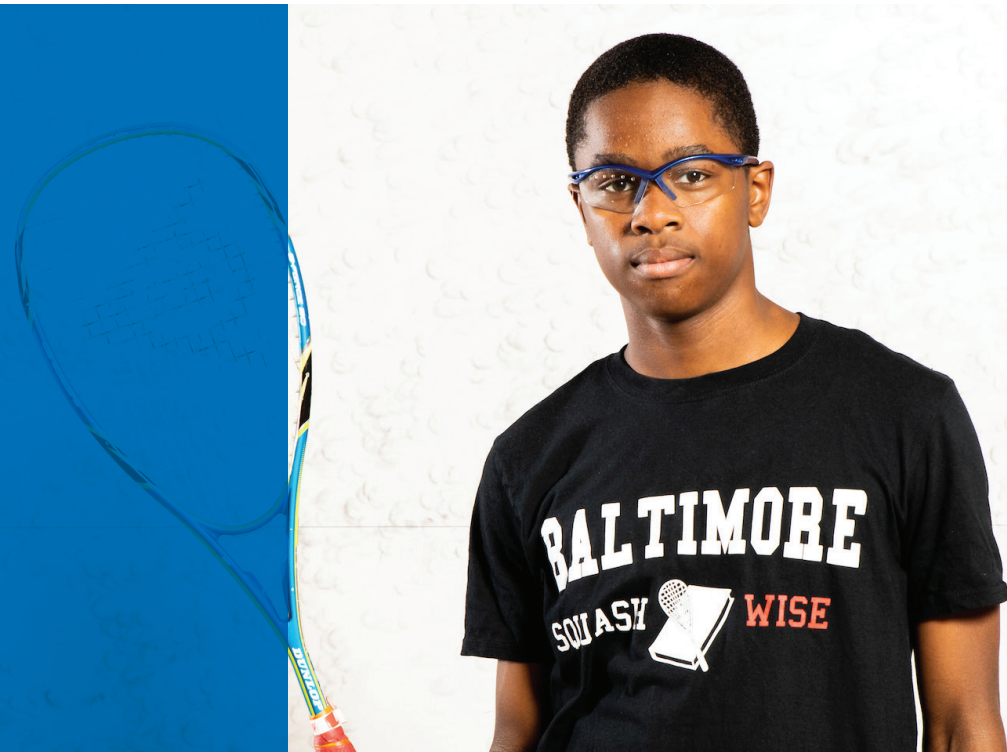

MIDDLE SCHOOL: JAE LIN

Jaelin joined SquashWise as a 7th Grader at KIPP, and his commitment to growing in every aspect of our program is truly inspiring. Most impressively, he is the only SquashWise student who has continued to maintain a 100% attendance average since his very first day! A resident of Greater Mondawmin, Jaelin worked very hard throughout his time in our middle school program to earn his space in the Ingenuity Program at Baltimore Polytechnic Institute, where he is now a freshman. In addition to attending SquashWise Summer Camp and the required summer classes at Poly, he also participated in a national squash training squad at University of Virginia (offered through the Squash + Education Alliance), and a squash camp with Omar Sobhy, a squash professional at Meadow Mill Athletic Club. These experiences prepared him to play in the Meadow Mill Bronze Tournament in August, where he finished Third Place in his division!



HIGH SCHOOL: NIJAH

Nijah joined SquashWise as a 7th grade student at KIPP. Since then, she has actively participated in many SquashWise opportunities, near and far. As a well rounded student, Nijah shows as much dedication on the squash courts as she does in the classroom. Her hard work and determination has allowed her to secure spots in some of our most rigorous academic summer programs including Yleana Leadership Program for SAT preparation, University of Rochester Pre-College Program, Hotchkiss Summer Portals Program, Regional Math and Science Center at Frostburg State University and Miss Porter's Summer Program. Nijah currently holds a cum laude GPA at Mercy High School where she is a senior. She has already been accepted to numerous universities and her future plans include becoming a dermatologist. She hopes to enroll in a college with a great STEM program.

Squash + Education Alliance: Member Review

SquashWise is a proud member of the Squash + Education Alliance, which provides resources and support to member programs serving more than 2,500 young people in 23 U.S. cities and five locations

abroad. Students in SEA programs experience tournaments and summer camps with peers from cities as varied as Chicago, Boston, New York, San Diego, and Detroit. Staff members receive in-depth professional development through conferences, affinity groups, and an annual Leadership Summit for staff and Board members.

SquashWise recently completed its peer review from SEA. After a two-day site visit and program observation, SquashWise received an overall score of "Strong" (3.93 out of 5.0).

SEA conducts an annual student survey to gauge student satisfaction and impact. This year's results show how strongly students benefit from friendship, mentorship, and athletic participation at SquashWise.

STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY:

87% of students report having caring adults who they can trust at SquashWise.

85% of students report having good friends at SquashWise.

85% of students report being more physically fit because of their participation.

85% of students report that they have opportunities to lead & contribute to the program in positive ways.

82% of students report that coming to SquashWise has helped them feel good about themselves.

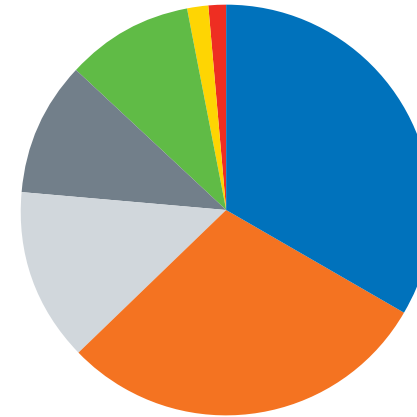
80% of students report that staff ask for & value their opinions about the program.

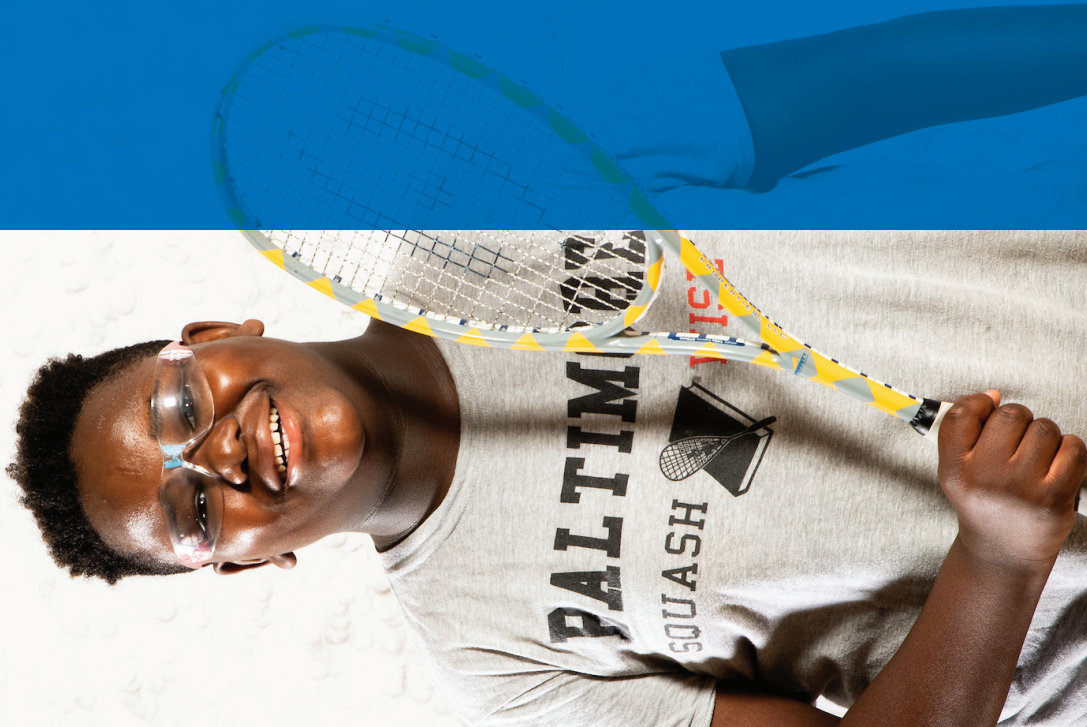
